One of our school policies is that when a group from school is on a trip and one of the students is not following the rules or creates a discipline problem, the parent is called and asked to come and get their child. Sometimes junior high students do things in a group that they would not consider doing if they were alone.

We mentioned in this letter that our personal appearance will be important when we are representing HCJH. Students are to wear their performance outfit for all four performances. Wednesday and Thursday students may change into casual clothes after the performances. They may wear shorts of an appropriate length or jeans, no tank tops (school dress code). Make up should be minimal and neat.

When we are at Magic Mtn. the students will be in groups of two or more. We will have two check in times and the students will be given a card with the staff cell phone numbers in case of an emergency. If you will not be going on the tour and want your student to be with a chaperone at all times, please send Mrs. Henslin a note or email.

# GUIDELINES AND BEHAVIOR FOR MUSIC TOUR

## LANGUAGE

Conversation must be appropriate, respectful and honoring to God.

Be polite – please and thank you! Be sure to thank bus drivers, hotel personnel, school personnel, etc.

## BUSES

No switching buses going or coming back

Stay seated on bus at all times

No rapping on the windows, screaming or yelling

No food or drink on the bus

## MEALS

Eat what you order or take

Talk quietly - Stay seated -No throwing food – Do not rearrange the furniture

Clean up your table and floor area when finished

## DRESS CODE

Wednesday: Come to school in your performance outfit. Bring a small bag with your casual clothes to take on the bus. Casual clothes - shorts or pants- NO tank tops – all clothing must fit properly and have appropriate pictures/messages (school dress code).

Thursday: Performance outfit until after the second performance, then you may change into your casual clothes. Make sure you bring a small bag with your casual clothes on the bus.

Friday: Casual clothes

## PERFORMANCES

Set up quickly and quietly - Everyone helps set up and tear down.

**Absolute quiet** when other groups are performing.

## HOTEL

Be with your chaperone when you get off the bus and at all times while at the hotel.

No switching rooms

No diving – be careful for little children in the pool

No fighting or screaming in pool

No one outside their rooms after 9:30 p.m.

## MAGIC MOUNTAIN

Meet at the group ticket window

Take a group picture as soon as we get inside

Stay in groups of 2 or more all day

Check in with Mrs. Henslin/Ms. Valdez at 1:30 p.m. at the main entrance

Check in at the main entrance at 5:00 p.m. – **ON TIME**

## **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

This includes MP3 players, CD players, GameBoy/DS, etc. Ipods can be used in the hotel room **ONLY**

## **CELL PHONES**

Students may bring cell phones for calls home at night **only**. Student phones **must** be off during the day.

**NO GUM**-except at Magic Mtn.

**CAMERAS** – you can bring a camera, but **may not** use it in the hotel.
