- Are issued I-20s
- Receive credit for school work
- Can enroll for any length of time
- Must pay tuition in-full

### International Visitors

- Are not issued I-20s
- Do not receive credit for school work
- Can visit for any length of time
- Must pay tuition in 2-month increments, flat-rate

### Learning English

Our schools do not currently offer English classes. We have found that our International Students learn English rapidly through play and socialization.

### Academics

**Junior High:** Bible is taught as an academic subject at each grade level, as well as Science, Math, Computers, and Physical Education. All students attend chapel once a week. In addition to the above courses, **6th Graders** learn Spanish, art, music, reading, writing, spelling, and more. **7th Graders** take English, Social Studies, "Lunatic, Liar or Lord?", Web Tools and Music Appreciation courses. **8th Graders** take English, History, Web Tools, Perspectives, and Integrity courses. Over 25 electives and special topics are offered to students in addition to the above courses.

**Elementary:** Bible is taught as an academic subject at each grade level, as well as Music, Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, P.E., Spanish, Art, Computers, and Health and Safety. All students attend Chapel once a week.
