## Course Description

### Subject: PowerPoint

#### Overview:

This class is an elective class and meets two days a week for one quarter. The class is usually taught one quarter a year. The skills and concepts covered in the class include creating a 10-slide slide show on a subject of the student's choice. The student will add features to the slide show to illustrate the subject, emphasize specific information and make the slide show more fun to watch. The student will present the slide show in class to their classmates.

#### Primary Biblical Integration: Exodus 31:3

"and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship"

**Matthew 28:19** "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations..."

#### Unit Description:

- ✠ Slide Show – The students will research and design a 10-slide slide show on a subject of their choice. The student will use the Internet as their resource tool. They will include information from their sources along with picture images for illustration purpose to inform their classmates on their chosen subject. The student will then add special effects, sound (background and sound effects), transitions, and hyperlinks. Once the slide show is complete the student will create and print note cards using PowerPoint. Once the note cards are complete the student will present their slide show using the note cards to help in the presentation.
  
- ✠ **Photoshop Elements** – The students will scan or bring pictures on some form of media to add to their slideshow. The students will make color adjustments, crop, and color correct the picture images. They will also use various effects to enhance the picture images.
