
Course Description

Subject: Video Yearbook

Overview:

This class is an elective class that meets two days a week for two quarters. This class is offered as an "after-school" class the spring semester for a fee. The student may continue this class for multiple quarters or commit to one quarter only. The skills and concepts covered in the class include videotaping and taking digital pictures at school events throughout the school year. The students then capture, edit and finalize the video clips and digital pictures. A yearbook DVD is created and made available to the student body at the end of the year.

Unit Description:

✦ **Filming/Taking Digital Pictures** - The students take video and digital pictures at school events during the year

✦ **Video Edit** – The students capture the video into the computer (digital format). They will add special effects, transitions, background sound, and text to enhance the video.

✦ **Photoshop Elements** – The students will upload the digital pictures to the computer. They will make color adjustments, crop, and color correct the picture images. They will also use various effects to enhance the picture images. The digital pictures will be added to the final project.

✦ **DVD Cover/Label** – The students will create a DVD cover and DVD label for the Yearbook DVD.
