SPRING MUSIC TOUR

Dear Music Parents:

Plans are being finalized for our Spring Music Tour to San Diego on May 5-7. We will leave school on three tour buses on Wednesday, May 5 and perform at Mission Hills Christian School on the way to San Diego and at Mt. Miguel Covenant Village (retirement home) in the afternoon. We will also be at Belmont Park for rides and dinner that evening. Thursday, May 6 we will perform at Trinity Christian School in Spring Valley and at Seaport Village in the afternoon. Friday May 7 we will go to Sea World for the day and drive back to HCJH, arriving around 8:30 p.m.

The cost for the tour will be \$260.00 per student/chaperone. To help defray the cost of the trip, students and chaperones may want to participate in a candy fundraiser. The candy sale will run from Feb. 5-26, 2010. The candy comes in boxes of 50 (5 kinds of candy; 10 bars each) and is sold for \$1.00 per bar. The candy cannot be returned; the quantity requested by a student must be sold. Students may not sell candy on campus. Parents are requested to write one check for the total amount of candy sold. Checks should be made payable to Heights Christian Jr. High.

Proceeds from this fundraiser will help offset the cost of the trip for those that participate in the fundraiser. Based on individual participation, credits will be applied to student accounts. Please note that if a student does not go on the music tour for any reason, any fundraiser monies credited to individual student accounts remain the property of HCJH and are non-refundable.

I **MUST** know by Thursday, Jan. 28th if you want to sell candy and how many boxes. Whether you sell candy or not, students and chaperones must have their trip paid-in-full by **March 26, 2010**. If there is a problem, please contact me.

All students are expected to go on the tour. If there is a major conflict, I MUST know IMMEDIATELY as I have already made hotel reservations and need to send deposits soon.

Finally, with 102 students going on the tour, we will need about 34 chaperones. All chaperones will be able to ride on the buses and have a fun and relaxing time. You will be greatly appreciated.

We're looking forward to a great end of the year in our Music Dept. Thank you for the privilege of working with your students.
